### Osaka No.1 Branch Camp (Minato-ku, Osaka)

Established at 3-chome, Gojo-dori, Minato-ku, Osaka City on September 23, 1945. Was burnt down in the air raid on June 1, 1945, and the camp office was moved to an elementary school building at Aza-shimoshinden, Shinden-mura, Mishima-gun (current Senriyama, Suita City), Osaka Pref. on July 11. At that time, the POWs were moved to Nishinomachi, Kitafukuzaki, Minato-ku, Osaka City and Osaka No.1 Branch Camp was established there. Closed in September 1945.

The POWs were used by Nippon Express Company and so on, and they worked at Osaka Harbor or railway stations in Osaka. Some other POWs worked at ironworks in Osaka. 443 POWs (326 British, 42 American, 24 Chinese, 19 Indian, 17 Dutch and 15 others) were imprisoned at the end of the war. 154 men died while imprisonment.
